



PROCLAMATION

Building Safety Month-May 2022

WHEREAS Ontario Municipalities are committed to recognizing that our growth and strength depends on the safety and essential role our homes, buildings and infrastructure play, both in everyday life and when disasters strike, and;

WHEREAS our confidence in the structural integrity of these buildings that make up our communities are achieved through the devotion of vigilant guardians-building officials, fire prevention officials, architects, engineers, builders, tradespeople, design professionals, and others in the construction industry--who work year-round to ensure the safe construction of buildings, and;

WHEREAS modern building codes include safeguards to protect the public from hazards such as hurricanes, snowstorms, tornadoes, wildland fires, floods and earthquakes, and;

WHEREAS Building Safety Month, a campaign launched by the International Code Council and supported by the Large Municipalities of Chief Building Officials (LMCBO) and the Ontario Building Officials Association (OBOA), is intended to remind the public about the critical role of our communities' largely unknown protectors of public safety--our local code officials--who assure us of safe, sustainable and affordable buildings that are essential to our prosperity, and;

WHEREAS "Safety for All: Codes in Action," the theme for Building Safety Month 2022, encourages us all to raise awareness about planning for safe and sustainable construction; career opportunities in building safety; understanding disaster mitigation, energy conservation; and creating a safe and abundant water supply to all of our benefit, and;

WHEREAS each year, in observance of Building Safety Month, people all over the world are asked to consider the commitment to improve building safety, resilience and economic investment at home and in the community, and to acknowledge the essential service provided to all of us by our building regulatory departments, fire prevention bureaus and national and international agencies in protecting lives and property.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Township of Faraday does hereby proclaim the month of May 2022 as Building Safety Month. Accordingly, we encourage citizens to join with their communities in recognizing Building Safety Month.
