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CRISIS INTERVENTION CENTRE SERVICES

Our highly-trained, multidisciplinary team of crisis workers is there to respond to crisis calls and offer emergency mental health intervention including assessments, referrals, short-term crisis resolution and/or simply to provide information.

Our affiliation with Quinte Health Care's Mental Health Program and the Department of Psychiatry allows us to access many clinical resources.

Who do we help?

Assistance is available to any adult (16 years and older) experiencing a psychological, emotional or situational crisis requiring immediate, short-term assistance. The Crisis Intervention Centre can be contacted by family members, family doctors, health care providers or social services agencies. People may also call directly and do not require a referral.
