Purpose and Effect of the Proposed Amendment:

The Township of Faraday is a part of the County of Hastings. The County of Hastings updated their Official Plan in 2017. The Official Plan was approved by the Ontario Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing on August 3, 2018. The Township of Faraday is undertaking an Administrative Amendment to the Comprehensive Zoning By-Law to bring it into conformity with the Hastings County Official Plan pursuant to Section 26 (9) of the Planning Act.

Key Map: This is a Township-wide amendment; therefore, a description of the subject land or a key map is not provided with this notice.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Township of Faraday to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Faraday before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Faraday before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
